



READING THE REPORT

This report should be used as a guide to help monitor trends in your school area's community spread level of COVID-19, and when it may be safe to return to (or continue with) in-person learning. A school's individual COVID-19 mitigation plan is also an important factor in determining when it is safe to resume in-person learning. Schools should be prepared to move between delivery models throughout the 2020-2021 school year as community spread changes. Here are some key points to remember when reviewing your area data:

- 1 Your area's **Most Recent Data [1]** is just as important to review as the **Prior Week's Data [2]**. The overall risk level is based on 2 consecutive weeks of data. Learn about data timeframes on the [dashboard page](#).
- 2 The highest risk color (i.e. **Red** is highest, then **Yellow**, then **Green**) shown in any benchmark on the card over 2 consecutive weeks of data determines the overall risk level and color on the map. For example, if your report has 4 greens and 2 yellows, your risk level of spread will be Moderate and the map area will be yellow because it is the higher risk value.

Overall Risk Level: Substantial

Recommended Learning Scenario

- Cases Per 100k People:** More than 100 cases
- Percent Positivity:** More than 10%
- COVID-like Illness:** More than 10%



Virtual w/ Onsite Support

All 3 benchmarks in the **Red** category recommend virtual w/ onsite support in consultation w/ Public Health. *(If ≥ 1 benchmarks are in the 'red' category for ≥ 2 weeks, consult Public Health about preparation for virtual w/ onsite support)*

Overall Risk Level: Moderate

Recommended Learning Scenarios

- Cases Per 100k People:** 10-100 cases
- Percent Positivity:** 5-10%
- COVID-like Illness:** 5-10%



Hybrid

All three benchmarks met in the **Yellow** or **Yellow** and **Green** categories for two consecutive weeks.

Overall Risk Level: Minimal

Recommended Learning Scenario

- Cases Per 100k People:** Less than 10
- Percent Positivity:** Less than 5%
- COVID-like Illness:** Less than 5%



Traditional

All three benchmarks met in the **Green** category for two consecutive weeks.
